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Jason Ramsey Certified To Fit Bionic i-LIMB Hand

(Nashville, Tenn.) – Jason Ramsey, licensed prosthetist of Bulow Biotech Prosthetics (BBP), has recently been certified to fit the i-LIMB Hand. Ramsey attained the certification after attending a Prosthetic Advances training course in Dallas, Texas on April 9. The training session covered clinical background, patient selection, fitting, patient training, service and support.

Developed by Touch Bionics, the i-LIMB is the world's first available multi-articulating bionic hand. Featuring five individually powered digits, a multi-position thumb and an optional ultra-realistic cosmetic skin, it represents the start of a new generation in hand bionics.

A traditional two-input myoelectric (muscle signal) sensor system controls the i-LIMB Hand by reading nerve impulses from residual limb through the skin with no invasive fittings controls. A similar control system is used on existing simple myoelectric prosthetics, so the opening and closing functionality takes little training. The grip support on the i-LIMB gives amputees the freedom to perform numerous tasks they couldn't do before including holding a fork, picking up a coin and operating computer keyboards, to name a few. For new patients, the hand offers a level of flexibility and dexterity that has never before been available. .

“Receiving the certification from Touch Bionics as an accredited i-LIMB practitioner is quite exciting,” said Ramsey. “This advanced technology allows me to do my job better, providing our patients with a solution that enhances and improves their day-to-day lives.”

In addition to his i-LIMB Hand certification, Ramsey also has experience in lower and upper extremity prosthetics, myoelectric arms, and other bionic technology.
